-  Recommended Group Size: 15 (min) – 30 (max)
-  Suitable Age Group: Min 13 yrs old
-  Other Info: Each 5-hour session includes a one-hour lunch break. Lunch is not included for this program. The full program of 8 hours can be conducted within a day.
